Sue commenced medicine at Monash in 1969, and graduated in 1975 after completing a B. Med. Sc. in O&G in 5th year.

At the end of 5th year, Sue married Ian Hunter (a 1974 graduate), and early in their working lives they moved to the Hobart area, where Sue worked in general practice.

Sue and Ian loved playing bridge and hiking ... Once Ian had taken Sue on a hike in Tasmania, she was hooked, going on hikes including through Africa and Kazakhstan - often with Ian but sometimes with girlfriends.
